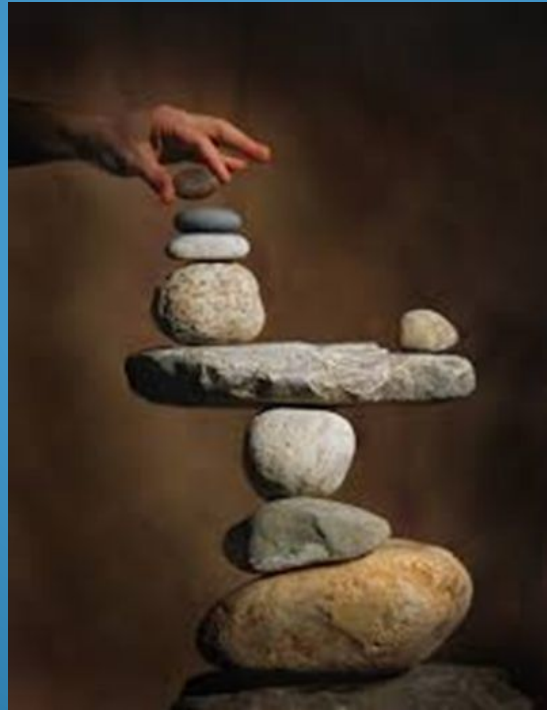

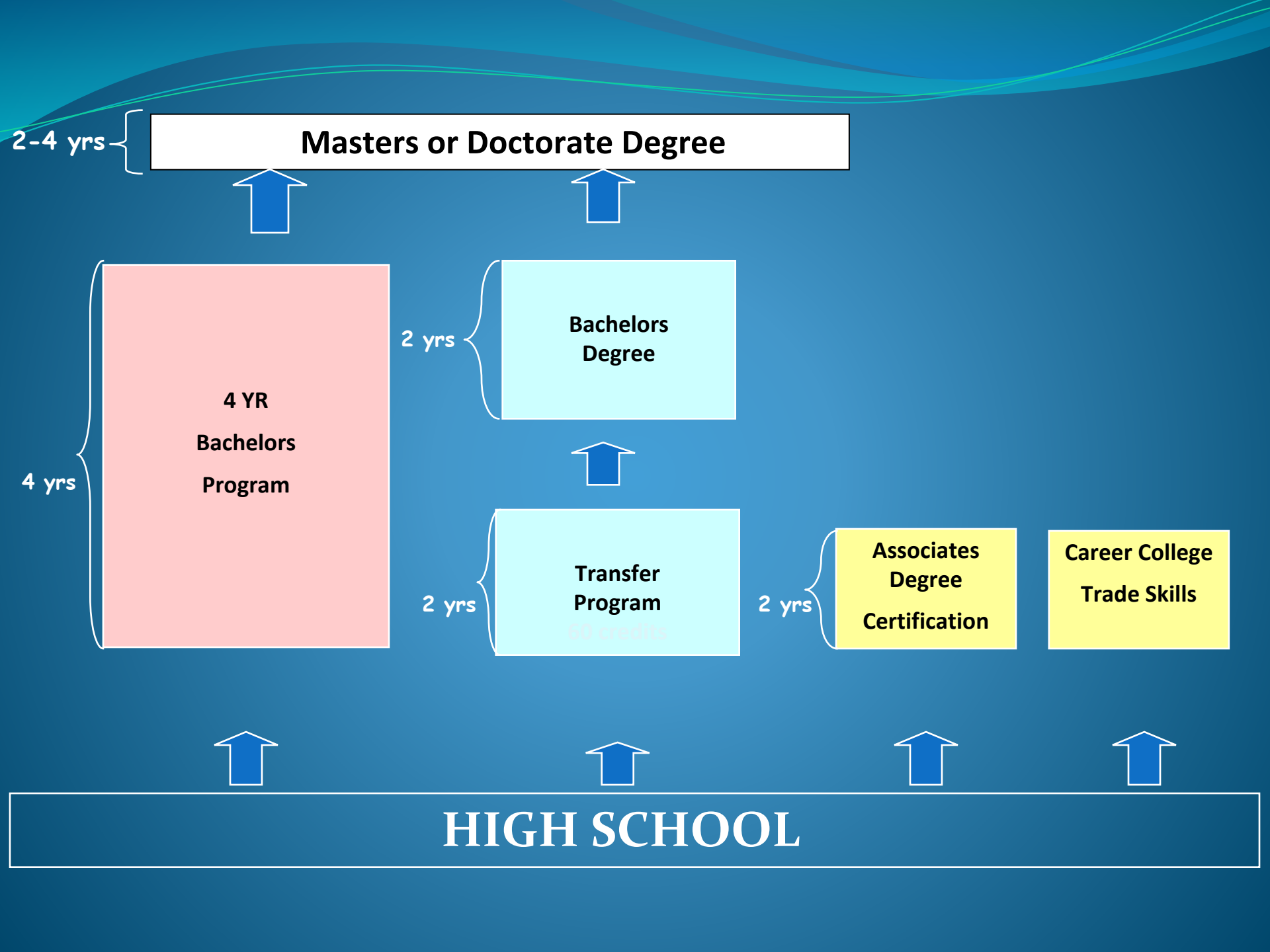

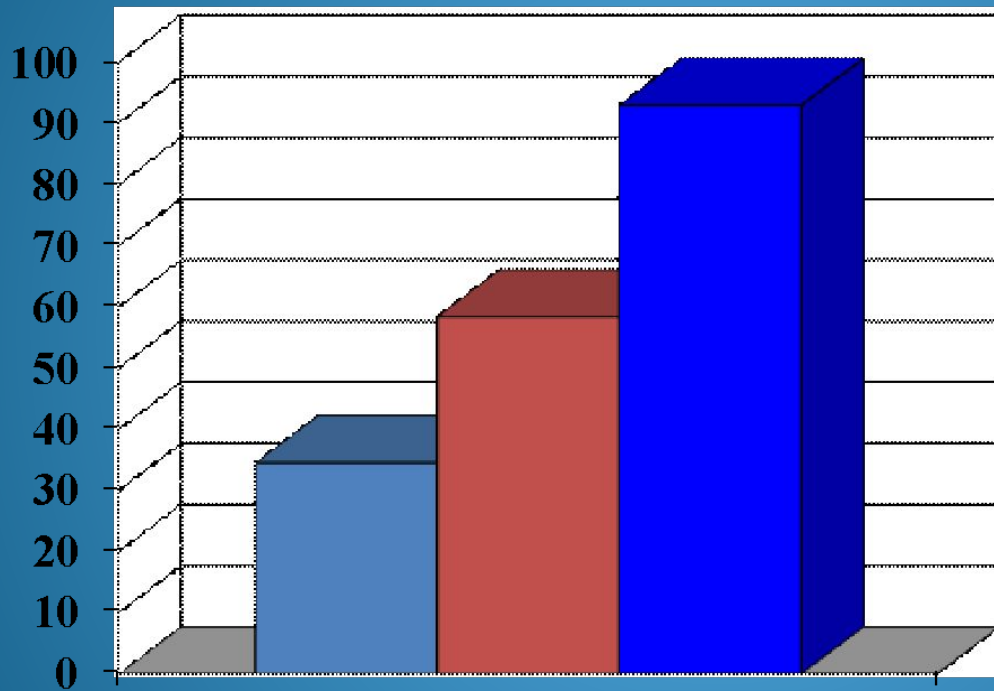

College Entrance Tests



- Take the PSAT in 10th & 11th grade
- Take the SAT and/or ACT in 11th & 12th grade
- Subject tests may be required for some majors – check with the university – can be taken up to December of student's 12th grade year

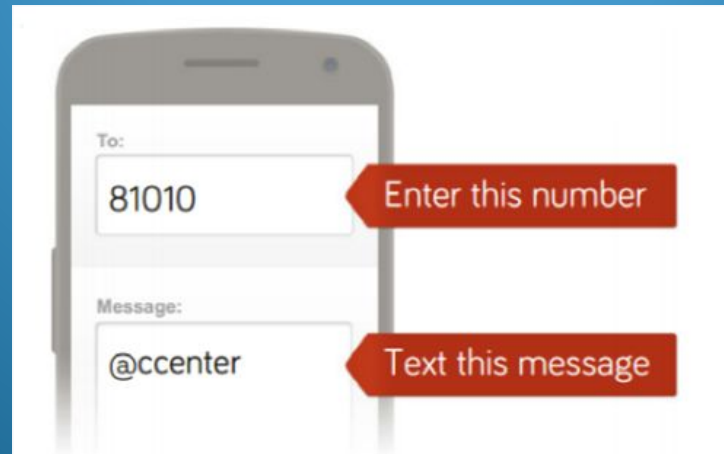

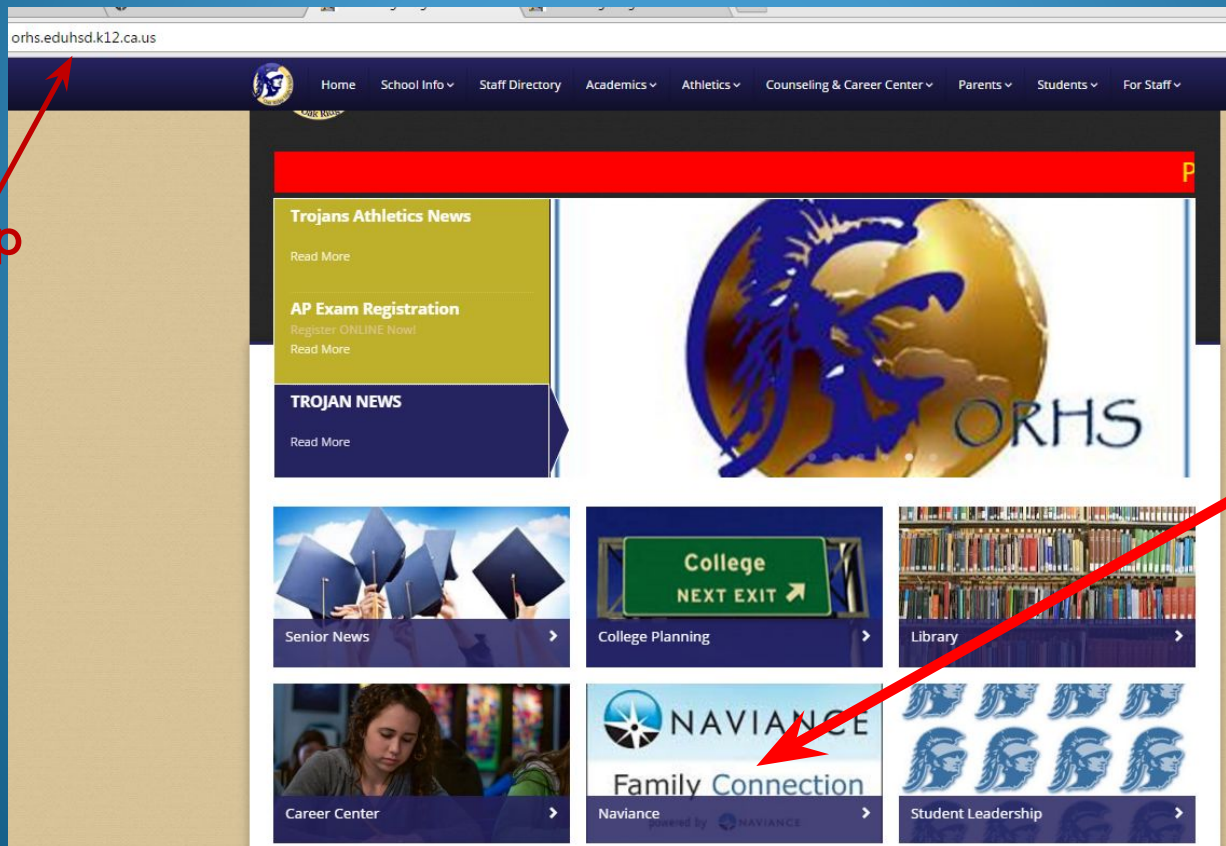
