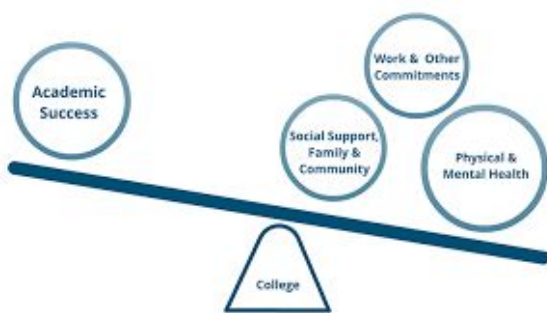

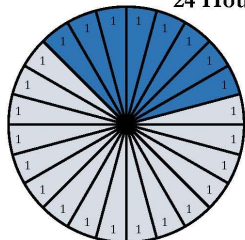

REGISTRATION AND COURSE SELECTION

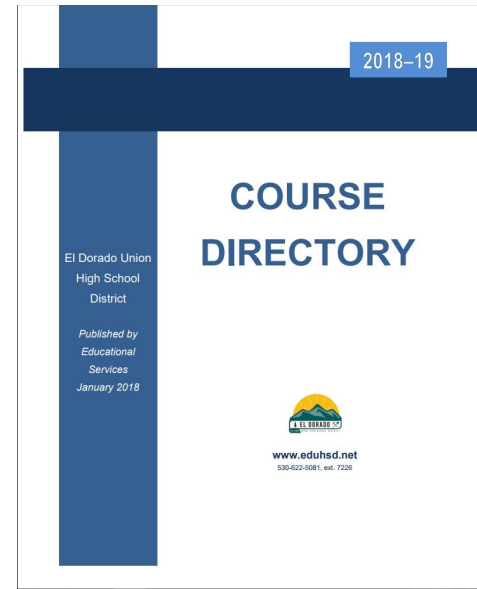
- 1st period continues to be random selection - **This is a request, not a guarantee.**
- Students who are repeating classes or who are credit deficient are given a priority for receiving 7 classes.
- All requests for 7 classes and 1st period classes are contingent upon staff and class availability
- Students will select 6 or 7 classes. When reviewed by the counselor, the counselor will note on the schedule what you are requesting - ex. 1-6, 2-7 or 1-7. Please do not make any commitments (carpool, athletics, employment, etc.) until we have confirmed your schedule. It is our hope that we will be able to provide you with this information at the end of May.

REGISTRATION AND COURSE SELECTION NOTES CONTINUED...

- If selecting Leadership, please follow up with the application which is located in N1. If selecting Academic Peer Tutor, TA, or ROP class, please follow up with the application which is located in the Counseling Office.
- To be enrolled in Chemistry or Advanced Chemistry, students must be enrolled in Algebra 2, Advanced Algebra 2 or a higher level of math. Students cannot be concurrently enrolled in Geometry and Chemistry or Advanced Chemistry.
