


### Oak Ridge Data for Class of 2017

- History/Social Science 2 Years
- > English 4 Years
- > Mathematics 3 Years through Algebra 2 (UC recommends 4 yrs)
- Lab Science 2 Years (UC recommends 3 yrs)
- Foreign Language 2 Years (UC recommends 3-4 yrs)
- > Visual & Performing Arts 1 Year
- > College Prep Elective 1 Year


