



# **ATTENDANCE**

Absence Verification:

Reasons for student absences are to be verified by a phone call to the attendance office, or a note brought to the Attendance office, **within 48 hours** of the absence.

Early Dismissal/Late Arrival:

Please send a note that includes the student's **name**, **grade**, **time**, **date** and **reason** for arrival/dismissal.

Every student must checkout with the attendance office before leaving school for any reason.

May 20-24, 2019






