Senior Notification

- Purpose:

Encourage a strong finish and provide accountability in the areas of Academics, Attendance, and Behavior

Timeline:

- Distributed in English classes week of Feb 18th
- Due to Assistant Principal's Office by Fri, March 1st
- Notification goes into effect Monday, March 18th

Senior Notification Details

- Academics
 - Must complete 240 credits and pass all required courses by May 24, 2019
- Attendance
 - Must maintain good attendance in all class.
 - Ten or more EXCUSED full or partial day absences in a school year is considered excessive and will result in administrative consequences
 - 3 full day or single period (same period) UNEXCUSED absences is considered truant may impact participate in graduation ceremony
- Behavior
 - If suspended for any reason in 4th quarter, a student cannot participate in the senior activities and may have to appeal participation in the graduation ceremony. Behavior standards apply for school and school-sponsored activities.
 - Graduation Practice attendance is Mandatory



Fines/Fees

Finance Office

- Make sure all fines/fees are paid by May 23, 2019. It is recommended to check for fines in advance of Senior Check Out.
- All Fines must be paid in order to participate in senior check-out.
- A student cannot participate in the graduation ceremony if they have any outstanding fines or fees.

MAY 24, 2019 - 7:00 PM, ORHS STADIUM

- The Oak Ridge High School Graduation Ceremony is a community celebration of the accomplishments of the class of 2019.
- The ceremony is a dignified ceremony, not a party.
- We appreciate parental and community support in maintaining the dignity of the ceremony.



THE CEREMONY

- Photos will also be taken as each Senior receives their diploma
- No tickets are required
- All gates to the stadium will open for admission at 5:45pm.
- Seating is very limited, Seat saving will not be permitted.
- Assisted Seating: Information will be available at a later date, via a Parent Square communication.
- There will be a maximum of 4 seats per family for Assisted seating
