



2025 AP EXAM REGISTRATION

Taking the Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Oak Ridge High School highly encourages all students to take AP exams for the AP classes they are enrolled in. Scoring well on an AP exam can earn a student college credit, enhancing the college application and saving a significant amount on tuition.

For the 2025 AP exams, students at Oak Ridge High School will register online. **This is a two-step process.** The registration will take a few minutes and can be completed from any computer with internet access.

Exam Fee:

This year, each AP exam will cost **\$99.00**. Students have the option to pay for the exam(s) in full at the time of registration, or place a \$40 deposit per exam.

Reduced Exam Fee:

For those who submit an application for reduced fees AND meet income qualification, each exam will cost \$15.00.

- 1) To see if you qualify, submit our [district EZMealApp](#) online and then wait for approval via email (this typically takes 24 hours). Can't click the link? Find the application on the ORHS website. From the homepage, go to the "Counseling/College & Career Center" tab/page. Then go to the "Advanced Placement" page.
- 2) **IMPORTANT!** Wait for approval via email. Then, during online registration, in the Total Registration portal, when prompted, remember to indicate that you qualify for a reduced fee.

STEP 1: Join Your AP Classroom(s) on College Board

Go to apstudents.collegeboard.org, sign-in to your student account, and join your AP Classroom(s).

Simply joining the College Board AP Classroom **does not** order your AP exams.
Total Registration must be used to order and pay for each exam. See Step 2 below.

STEP 2: Order & Pay for Exam(s) Online

Online registration opens on Monday, September 9, 2024 at 8:00am. and closes on Wednesday, March 5, 2025 at 3:59pm. **Any order placed after November 12th @ 3:59 PM will incur a \$40 late ordering fee per exam.**

To order exams, students should click on the link provided on the school website or visit www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/050818. The order is not complete until the student prints the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end of registration. **We strongly recommend that parent and student are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered and the STUDENT name is entered correctly.**

Note about Payment:

Have a credit or debit card available before beginning registration. Student/Parent will choose whether to pay their entire balance without an additional fee or make a partial payment/deposit for a fee of \$2.75, charged by Total Registration.

Important Dates & Information:

- Monday, Sept. 9, 2024 at 8:00 AM - Registration Opens (use the link under Step 2, above)
- Tuesday, Nov. 12, 2024 at 3:59 PM – Registration and payments submitted after this date will incur a \$40 late fee per exam.
- **NOTE:** Spring AP Govt/Econ will **NOT** incur a late fee. Registration for these exams can occur until the March 5th deadline.
- Wednesday, March 5, 2025 at 3:59 PM - Registration Closes
- Thursday, March 6, 2025 at 3:59 PM - Registrations not paid in full will be canceled and exams will not be ordered.
- If a student cancels an exam after an exam was ordered, College Board will charge a \$40 cancellation fee per exam.
