

EDUHSD Algebra 1 Challenge Placement Exam for Incoming 9th Graders

This exam is for students who wish to test out of Algebra One and accelerate into Geometry as a freshman. This will then qualify the student to take Biology as their science class. It is our strong recommendation the student then follows-up with Advanced Algebra 2. In order to do so, the student must demonstrate competence in the following Algebra 1 categories. **This exam consists of all short answer questions - a scientific calculator is allowed.**



Recommendation for acceleration into Geometry will be based on:

- **Scoring at least an 80% overall total score**

Prerequisites:

A student who wants to take challenge placement exam must have met at least one of the following prerequisites:

- Currently in an 8th grade course 3 (or equivalent) with 90% or better.
- Currently in Algebra 1 in 8th grade but were not recommended for Geometry at the time of registration.
