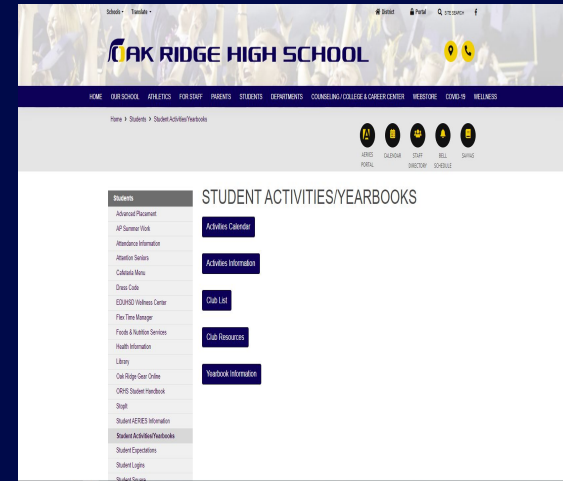



ATTENDANCE

Absence Verification:

- Reasons for student absences are to be verified by a phone call to the attendance office, response to auto dialer, or a note brought to the Attendance office, within **48 hours** of the absence.



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ATTENDANCE

Early Dismissal/Late Arrival:

- Please send a note that includes the student's **name, grade, time, date and reason** for arrival/dismissal.
- Every student must checkout with the attendance office before leaving school for any reason.
